CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Always ensure that the equipment you purchase is suitable for the application for which it is intended, if you are not sure seek the advice of an authorised Beaver dealer. Prior to use ensure that your equipment is in good condition and free from faults or damage that may impair its proper use.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Your Beaver Octopus Loop is designed to keep your octopus alternative air source in a safe, comfortable and convenient location, enabling quick and easy access should it be required.
2. Gently place your head through the larger space until the Octopus Loop is comfortably located around your neck, taking care not to over stretch the elasticated silicone.
3. Carefully place your octopus in the small retaining section provided ensuring that it is not too tight around your neck and take care not to over stretch .
4. Never fasten your Octopus Loop or Octopus in a position that may obstruct or hinder the safe and correct operation of other equipment, interfere with other persons or cause damage to the underwater environment. If in any doubt, consult your Beaver Retailer.
5. After completing your dive carefully remove the Octopus Loop ensuring that you do not over stretch the elasticated silicone.
6. After use rinse your Octopus Loop in clean fresh water and store in a dry ventilated area.
