VALVED SURFACE MARKER BUOY

This Beaver Valved Surface Marker Buoy is an integral part of your diving equipment and should be treated with as much care as the rest of your accessories. It is designed for indicating a Divers position below the water surface during decompression, it must not be used for personal buoyancy, assisting your ascent, lifting items from beneath the water or to indicate your position throughout a dive. This Beaver Valved Surface Marker Buoy has been manufactured to stringent quality control regulations, giving you a product which is strong, durable and will give years of trouble-free service, providing it is handled and maintained correctly.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Always ensure that the equipment you purchase is correct for the application for which it is intended, if you are not sure seek the advice of an authorised Beaver Dealer.
2. Before use, ensure that your Beaver Valved Surface Marker Buoy is in good condition and free from any faults. Attach the pouch to a suitable position on your BCD or Harness, using a suitable Carabiner or Snap Hook, ensuring it is accessible and does not interfere with the operation of any other equipment.
3. To deploy your Beaver Valved Surface Marker Buoy, carefully remove from the pouch and attach a Line Reel fitted with an appropriate Carabiner or Snap Hook to the attachment ring and follow the instructions supplied with your Line Reel. Line Reels and attachment accessories are available from all Beaver Dealers.
4. Slowly inflate the Valved Surface Marker Buoy from the base using an Inflation Gun or Air Nozzle, these are available from all Beaver Dealers.
5. Use minimum tension on your Line Reel to ensure your Valved Surface Marker Buoy remains in the correct position on the surface above you.
6. Do not use for personal buoyancy, assisting your ascent, lifting items from beneath the water or to indicate your position throughout a dive.
7. Never apply excessive weight or tension to your Beaver Valved Surface Marker Buoy.
8. Do not allow your Beaver Valved Surface Marker Buoy to be dragged on the floor and avoid contact with sharp objects.
9. Once at the surface, detach your Valved Surface Marker Buoy from your Line Reel and deflate by carefully pulling on the exhaust cord located at the bottom of the Valved Surface Marker Buoy and store it securely in the pouch.
10. After use, thoroughly rinse in fresh water and allow to dry. Store in a dry location away from direct sunlight and any heat sources. Avoid any contact with solvents, detergents, oils etc.
